1. A3 attempts two free throws merited by A2. The error is discovered after the ball has again become live and while the ball is in the control of Team D. Shall the official stop the play and cancel any successful free throws followed by the alternating possession rule?
2. Player A3 holds the ball with both hands on his lap. Defender D4 reaches for the ball, but in doing so, makes contact with both hands of A3. The official assesses a personal foul on D4. Is this correct?
3. Team D is entitled to a throw-in under the alternating possession rule. The official erroneously awards the throw-in to Team A. The official discovers his error after the ball becomes live and stops the play to correct the situation. Is the official correct with this procedure?
4. Following a Team A field goal during the last two minutes of the game, the ball rolls far away from the court. The official inadvertently blows his whistle. The coach of Team A requests a time out during this dead ball period. The official does not grant the time out. Is the official correct?
5. A5 is cocked to begin his field goal attempt. Before the ball has been released, A4 is fouled by D4. The foul is the fifth foul for Team D in that period. The try is successful. The official counts the field goal and awards A4 with two free throws. Is the official correct?
6. A4 is in the act of shooting for a goal when D5 attempts to distract A4 by shouting loudly as he follows behind him. The shot for goal is unsuccessful. The official calls an unsportsmanlike technical foul to D5. Is the official correct?
7. A7 substitutes for A4. During the game, it is discovered Team A's point count exceeds the 14 point limit. Shall a technical foul be charged to A7 with a correction to the line-up made at the same time?
8. If a defensive player causes contact with an opponent from behind or laterally in an attempt to stop a fast break and there is no opponent between the ball carrier and the opponent's basket, then the contact shall be judged to be unsportsmanlike. Is this correct?
9. The maximum height from the floor to the top of the cushion, when a cushion is used, or the top of the seat platform, when a cushion is not used must not exceed 63 cm for a 2.5 point classified wheelchair player. Is this correct?
10. A4 retrieves a ball from the floor by leaning forward while both hands are removed from the rear wheels and both rear wheels rise from the floor. The official calls a violation on A4. Is the official correct?
11. A person who alters his chair after a chair check has been administered so that it is not in accordance with the rules will be assessed a disqualifying foul. Is this correct?
12. D3 intercepts a pass from his opponents near the centre line while both hands are off the wheels and his momentum returns him into his backcourt. The official calls D3 on a back-court violation. Is the official correct?
13. With 1:47 left in the 4th period, A3 scores a field goal. The game clock stops. A8 is at the table, waiting to substitute. Shall A8 be permitted to enter the game at this time?
14. During a time-out, Coach D requests the official to check the chair of A5. The official finds the chair to be legal. Shall a technical foul be assessed to Team D coach?
15. Player A has been in control of the ball for five seconds in his backcourt when a held ball occurs. The alternating possession arrow favors Team A. Is Team A entitled to a new 8 seconds period to cause the ball to go into Team A's frontcourt?

16. The ball is in the hands of A4 for a throw-in in A's front court when D5 makes excessive contact with A5 as he wheels through the restricted area. The official calls a personal foul on D5. Is the official correct?
17. A5 is dribbling toward his opponent's basket. Defender D5 wheels backwards across the path of A5 and covers the path of A5. A5 collides hard into D5. The official calls a charging foul on A5. Is the official correct?
18. The official shall stop the game at an appropriate time to allow a team to complete a chair repair. If the repair cannot be completed within 50 seconds or less the player must be substituted. Is this correct?
19. A personal foul shall be charged against the player, who raised both rear wheels off the floor, while both hands are removed from the rear wheels and he has come into contact with an opponent. The official judges that this contact creates a disadvantage for the opponent. Is this correct?
20. A4's final free throw is successful. Before the ball is at the disposal of a Team D player for a throw-in, Coach D requests a time out. Shall the request be granted?
21. A3 makes two pushes on his large wheels as he approaches his basket. He deliberately throws the ball against the backboard, catches the ball, and pivots with one push, shoots and scores. The official calls a violation on A3 for three pushes and cancels the basket. Is the official correct?
22. A5 is assessed his third technical foul during the game. By rule, shall A5 be ejected?
23. A4, while holding the ball, wheels around a defender and makes sudden contact with his own player causing both his rear wheels to lift off the floor while both hands are removed from the rear wheels. The official calls a violation on A4. Is the official correct?
24. Team A is granted a time-out. After 30 seconds have elapsed, Team A is ready to play. Shall play resume immediately?
25. A5 with one hand on the rear wheel tilts and lifts one rear wheel and one front castor off the floor while trying to intercept a pass. The official calls a technical foul on A5 for tilting. Is the official correct?

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
