



Wheelchair Basketball Canada

2009 - 2010 National Examination

1. During the game, the officials discover that player A4's seat-plate is temporarily fixed to his chair. The maximum height of the chair platform is legal. May player A4 play with this wheelchair?
2. The ball is in the hands of A5 for a throw-in in A's front court when D5 holds A4 as he wheels through the restricted area. The official calls a personal foul on D5. Is the official correct?
3. As the official is about to hand the ball to player A4 for a throw-in, he realizes that player A5 has not left the restricted area and advises A5 to leave. Is this a violation on Team A if A5 leaves?
4. Player A4 in control of the ball, while both hands are removed from the wheels, contacts a team-mate and his rear wheels come off the floor while attempting to pass the ball. The official calls a technical foul on A4 for lifting. Is this a technical foul?
5. Player A4 successfully prevents a ball from going out-of-bounds but, in doing so, and while not in contact with the ball, goes out-of-bounds. He immediately re-enters the court and takes control of the ball. Is this legal?
6. Player A4 jumps his wheelchair laterally to separate from a block while in the restricted area, while both hands are removed from the rear wheels. The official calls a technical foul on Player A4 for lifting. Is the official correct?
7. A4 and D4 contest the tap-off at the start of the game. The ball is tapped and caught by two opposing players A5 and D5. The official calls held ball and signals for a tap-off with the original players to restart the game. Is this the correct procedure?
8. A9 applies for substitution at the scorer's table. After the table has sounded the signal to request substitution, coach A indicates that he wishes to cancel the request. The official approves his request. Is the official correct?
9. A5 is cocked to begin his field goal attempt. Before the ball has been released, A4 is fouled by D5. The foul is the fifth foul for Team D in that period. The try is successful. The official counts the field goal and awards A4 with two free throws. Is the official correct?
10. Player A4 moves with the ball in the direction of the basket. D4 moves parallel to him. Near the boundary line of the restricted area A4 realizes that he cannot approach the basket for a lay up without correcting his direction. A4's footrest is ahead of D4's. A4 brakes his inner wheel to move his wheelchair in the direction of the basket. D4 contacts

A4 with his footrests and the contact causes A4 to fall out of his wheelchair. The official calls a personal foul on D4. Is the official correct?

11. In the closing 30 seconds of the game, D4 commits a personal foul on A4 away from the ball which the official judges that this foul was committed in order to stop the game clock. The official assesses this foul to be an unsportsmanlike foul on D4. Is this correct?

12. D4 intercepts a pass from his opponents near the centre line while both hands are off the wheels and his momentum returns him into his backcourt. The official calls D4 on a back-court violation. Is the official correct?

13. Player A4, in control of the ball, has executed two legal pushes. Afterwards he changes direction by braking his left wheel without moving the hand backwards. The official calls a traveling violation for three pushes. Is the official correct?

14. A4 and D4 both have firm control on the ball. In attempting to gain complete control of the ball, A4's right rear wheel goes out of bounds. Shall the ball be awarded to Team D because A4's wheelchair left the playing court?

15. Player A4, having released the ball on a shot for goal, prevents wheelchair contact with an opponent by putting one foot to the floor. The shot is successful. The official cancels the basket, calls a technical foul on A4 and awards Team D with two free throws and possession of the ball at centre. Is this the correct procedure?

16. Player A4 is in the act of shooting. D4 disconcerts A4 by waving his hand to obstruct the shooter's field of vision. The shot is unsuccessful. The official stops the play and calls a technical foul on D4. Is the official correct?

17. Player D5 commits an unsportsmanlike foul on A5 whose team is in control of the ball. The coach of Team A reacts with inappropriate behaviour to the call and is assessed a technical foul. Shall Team A have possession of the ball at the point of interruption with no reset of the 24-second device?

18. Offensive player A4 avoids a screen by crossing the sideline with the two right wheels and re-enters the court at the end-line. This is the first infraction by Team A. The official calls a violation on Team A and warns Coach A with this infraction. Is this the correct procedure?

19. A9 substitutes for A4. During the game, it is discovered Team A's point count exceeds the 14 point limit. Shall a technical foul be charged to Coach A with a correction to the line-up made at the same time?

20. Team A is in control of the ball and is developing a strong attack close to its opponent's basket when D4 falls out of his chair beneath the basket. The official

immediately stops the game. Team A is awarded possession of the ball for a throw-in from the sideline and the 24 second shot clock is reset. Is this the correct procedure?

21. A player shall be disqualified when he is charged with two unsportsmanlike fouls and shall go to, and remain in, his team's dressing room for the duration of the game or, if he so chooses, he shall leave the building. Is this the correct procedure?

22. Player A4, while holding the ball, makes contact with the side of an opponent's chair and both A4's rear wheels rise off the floor. The official determines the contact to be incidental and makes no call. Is the official correct?

23. Dribbler A4 is advancing the ball from his backcourt across the centre line with all wheels and castor(s) in the Team A's frontcourt but with the ball being dribbled in the backcourt. A4 then continues the dribble by returning with all wheels and castor(s) to the Team A's backcourt. Shall the eight-second count continue?

24. A4 attempts two free throws merited by A5. Only the second free throw is successful. Prior to Team D completing the throw-in, Team D coach indicates the wrong player attempted the free throws. Shall the official stop the play, cancel the successful free throw and follow this action by using the alternating possession rule?

25. A class 4.5 player, A4, with the ball in his hands, is in the act of shooting when D4 makes slight contact with A4's wheelchair. The official calls a personal foul on D4. Is this correct?
